They shared this house with another family named Hayashi who had two older sons (Yo and Butch) - In 309, Mr & Mrs Buichi Nakan and their three children - eldest daughter, sone George, daughter Kumi. The eldest daughter was married to a Watanabe and they had two children (Isao and Shigeru). They moved into their own house when more houses were built. - in another house (3157) a Tanaka Family lived. The father was a woodcutter and had three children including a son called Tommy. - on the east side of Third Avenue facing the Hayashi house was the Hasegawa house. Parents and one older son, George. - The first house on the opposite side (317) was the Nishihara's - parents & two older children. - Two doors down from the Hasegawas in the larger number direction was another Nishihara family - parents & three children (2 girls & a boy) - further towards the bathhouse was the Otsu house with one daughter name Miyako. Mrs. Otsu made & sold tofu - next to the Otsu house was the Ito house. Robert Ito was a dancer and later appeared on Quincey. He also danced with the National Ballet of Canada.
